Even though students are allowed to pay programme fees in instalments we encourage International students who need to apply for a Tier 4 student visa, to make their full fee payment before they apply for their visa, instead of just a deposit towards the programme. This has 2 advantages for the students:

1. A full fee payment made before the Tier 4 student visa application will significantly increase the chances of a successful visa application.
2. Full fees for a programme paid before registration will make the student eligible for a 5% fee waiver.

**Please note - Fees and instalments mentioned below are applicable for the June 2010 intake**

### MBA Full Time

Programme Fee : £ 6950

Deposit : £ 3000

Students may pay balance fees in instalments as follows:

### Weekend MBA

Programme Fee : £ 7950

### Masters Qualifying Programme (MQP) + MBA Full Time

Programme Fee : £ 8900 (£ 1950 towards MQP + £ 6950 towards MBA Full Time)

Deposit : £ 4950

Students may pay balance fees in instalments as follows:

9th August, 2010	13th December, 2010

### BA(Hons) in Business Administration

Programme Fee : £ 11850 (£ 3950 per level for 3 levels)

Deposit : £ 4000

Students may pay balance fees in instalments as follows:

## Degree Foundation Programme (DFP) + BA (Hons) in Business Administration

Programme Fee : £ 14800 (£ 2950 towards DFP + £ 11850 towards the 3 levels of the BA)

Deposit : £ 4950

Students may pay balance fees in instalments as follows:

## General Intensive English (GIE)

Programme Fee : £ 3000

Deposit : £ 3000 Programme fee + £ 2000 Deposit towards MBA/BA (Hons)

## English Grammar and Vocabulary (EGV)

Programme Fee : £ 1500

Deposit: £1500 Programme fee + £ 3000 Deposit towards MBA/BA (Hons)

## English for Academic Purposes (EAP)

Programme Fee : FREE

Deposit : Since the EAP programme is free, the deposit for the MBA/ BA following EAP is the same as mentioned on this fee sheet for MBA/ BA. Instalment amounts and dates for subsequent payments are mentioned on the fee payment plan which students receive along with the offer letter.

## Living Expenses

Students should allow a minimum amount of £ 600 per month for their living expenses when applying to TASMAC London. Most students need between £ 7500 and £ 9000 a year to cover their living and study expenses.

Below are examples of the approximate costs of some essential items you will need whilst you are in the UK:

- Accommodation (per week) £ 90-£ 190
- Food (per week) £ 25-£ 35
- Travel for a week £ 15-£ 20
- Books and equipment (per semester) £ 150
- Coat £ 20-£ 100
- Boots £ 30-£ 60
- Jeans £ 20-£ 60
- Warm jumper £ 10-£ 30
- Trainers £ 20-£ 80

The prices given are an approximate guide to costs.



## Funds for Tier 4 Student Visa Applications

International students requiring a Tier 4 student visa will need to show a minimum of £ 5400 for their living expenses to cover the first 9 months of stay in the UK

Under the new visa regulations the ONLY acceptable proof of maintenance funds is listed below:

- Cash in an account in your name (this includes joint accounts with your name); or
- A bank loan in your name; or
- Official government sponsorship
- Cash in account of a parent/legal guardian

International students will not be able to submit any other type of financial documents. It is important for international students to show that they have access to the funds, therefore, the UKBA states that students cannot use "sponsorship letters or be funded by relatives abroad without access to their bank accounts". Any documents used to show proof of the International Students maintenance funds **must be dated within 1 month of the submission** of the Tier 4 application. The appropriate maintenance funds must be in the account on the day of the Tier 4 visa application submission the funds **need to be in the account for at least 28 days**.

## Merit Based Scholarships

### MBA and BA Applicants:

#### Scholarship of £ 1000 for students who meet any one of the following requirements:

- GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. Please ask our Admissions Staff for assistance if your country does not use the GPA system of grading.
- A GMAT score of 600 or above.
- Evidence of **relevant** work experience of over 3 years **after** the Bachelors degree for MBA .

### MBA Applicants Only:

#### Scholarship of £ 2000 for students who meet any two of the following requirements:

- GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale. Please ask our Admissions Staff for assistance if your country does not use the GPA system of grading.
- A GMAT score of 650 or above.
- Evidence of **relevant** work experience of over 5 years **after** the Bachelors degree.

#### Scholarship of £ 3000 for students who meet both the requirements:

- A GMAT score of 700 or GPA of 3.75 on a 4.0 scale.
- Evidence of **relevant** work experience of over 7 years **after** the Bachelors degree.

If you wish to apply for the Merit Based Scholarship please submit a typed essay of a minimum 300 words entitled "Scholarship Support Statement", explaining:

1. Why you deserve the scholarship (your academic or professional qualities and your personal circumstances)
2. How will studying for a further business degree at TASMALC London contribute to your career ?
3. What do you have to offer to the TASMALC London student body?

The essay should be submitted at the same time as your application by email, fax or post. We will not be able to consider hand-written essays, so please submit a typed copy only. The decision on the amount of scholarship granted will be at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee at TASMALC London School of Business.

Please note that scholarships are awarded on full course fees only. Students with credit transfers will not be eligible for TASMALC scholarships.



## Refer a Friend Reward

We offer a special Refer a Friend Reward of £ 200 to a student for every friend that he/she refers to TASMAC London and who successfully enrolls for a Degree programme. This reward is given to the student in the form of a cheque after his/her friend enrolls at TASMAC London. One student can choose to refer any number of friends who may be interested in a programme at TASMAC London. However, the decision on whether a friend was an actual and fair referral by a student or not, is at the discretion of TASMAC London, based on the Refer a Friend Form being attached with the Application Form and the terms and conditions mentioned on the Refer a Friend Reward folder. A student who refers his/her Spouse or Sibling will not receive a Refer a Friend Reward as the spouse/ sibling will receive the Sibling / Spouse scholarship.

## Sibling and Spouse Scholarships

We are committed to rewarding the loyalty of students who have a sibling or spouse studying at TASMAC London. Applicants with a sibling who has studied or is studying at TASMAC London may be eligible for a 5% fee reduction for the duration of the course. This scholarship will be in the form of a discount, given to the student on the total fee that is payable to TASMAC London.

## 5% Fee waiver

Students will receive a 5% fee waiver on their tuition fees, if they make a full fee payment before commencement of the programme / at the time of registration. This fee waiver is only on tuition fees and does not apply to accommodation charges.

## Terms and Conditions for all Scholarships / Fee Waivers above

1. Applicants must hold an unconditional offer for a BA (Hons) in Business Administration or an MBA programme.
2. For BA(Hons) students, the Merit Based Scholarship of £ 1000 if awarded, will be distributed between all 3 years with a scholarship of £ 300 to be awarded in Year 1, £ 300 in Year 2 and £ 400 in Year 3 respectively.
3. Please note the above fee waivers and scholarships cannot be combined with any other offer. Students granted a scholarship will not be granted any waivers and students who requested any waivers will not be granted a scholarship.

## Please note (For all programmes)

1. The cost of textbooks, accommodation and other relevant course materials are NOT included in the tuition fees.
2. Where an applicant is issued a visa but fails to enrol or register in time for the programme at TASMAC London, the deposit is not refundable or transferable.
3. Where the applicant provides evidence (original visa refusal letter from the British High Commission) that the application for the student visa was not successful, the deposit/fees received from the student will be refunded. In other cases, deposit/fees once paid are non-refundable.



## Tuition Payment information

Payment of tuition fees may be made by any of the following means:

1. Bank draft, made payable to TASMAC London School of Business and forwarded to the school in London or its Asia Admissions Office (if the student is from Asia) or to the Admissions Partner through whose office the student may have applied for a programme at TASMAC London.
2. An electronic transfer direct to the TASMAC London School of Business bank account

3. **Pay Pal** : You may use Pay Pal to make a payment with a credit/debit card to TASMAC London School of Business.
