MBA Full Time

Programme Fee: £6950

After deducting the Nationality Scholarship of £1000 for the February 2009 intake, the fees applicable will be £5950

Students who pay the entire fee at the time of deposit or prior to the start of the programme will get a 5% fee reduction. It is advisable that students pay the entire fee at the time of accepting the offer, as this considerably increases the chances of getting a visa to the UK and helps students save 5% of the tuition fee.

Students who would like to pay in instalments will pay as follows:

Deposit: £3000

At the time of registration, upon arrival: Balance payment towards the fee (students who pay the balance fee in one instalment at the time of registration, or prior to the registration, will receive a 5% fee reduction).

After payment of the deposit, students who receive a Nationality Scholarship may be allowed to pay the balance in two equal instalments of £1475 each, the first instalment upon arrival at the time of registration and the balance after 8 weeks of the start of the First Semester :

MBA Part Time

Programme Fee: £7950

After deducting the Nationality Scholarship of £1000 for the February 2009 intake, the fees applicable will be £6950

Students who pay the entire fee at the time of application or prior to start of the programme will get a 5% fee reduction.

Students who would like to pay in instalments will pay as follows:

Deposit at the time of registration : £1950

The balance is payable in four instalments as below

1 st Installment - £1500	2 nd Installment - £1500	3 rd Installment - £1500	4 th Installment - £500
Within 8 weeks from the start of the 1st semester	Within 8 weeks from the start of the 2nd semester	Within 8 weeks from the start of the 3rd semester	Within 8 weeks from the start of the 4th semester

Please Note: This programme does not meet the UK Home Office requirements for students who need a visa to remain in the UK. Therefore, only residents of UK or EU or work permit holders of the UK can apply for the Part Time MBA programme and international students are not eligible.



BA (Hons) in Business Administration

The BA (Hons) in Business Administration Programme is divided into 3 years. The fee for each year is £3950

After deducting the Nationality Scholarship of £1000, as explained on the page on Nationality Scholarship in this fee sheet, fees for the BA (Hons) programme will be as follows - £3650 for year 1, £3650 for year 2 and £3550 for year 3

Students who pay the entire fee of all 3 years at the time of deposit or prior to start of the programme will get a 5% fee reduction. It is advisable that students pay the entire fee at the time of accepting the offer, as this considerably increases the chances of getting a visa to the UK and helps students save 5% of the tuition fee.

Students who would like to pay in instalments will pay as follows:

Deposit : Year 1 fee of £3650

The balance fee for year 2 and 3 is payable as below

Masters Qualifying Programme (MQP)

Programme Fee: £1950

Students who pay the entire fee of the Masters Qualifying Programme and the MBA programme at the time of deposit or prior to start of the programme will get a 5% fee reduction on both the programmes. It is advisable that students pay the entire fee at the time of accepting the offer, as this considerably increases the chances of getting a visa to the UK and helps students save 5% of the tuition fee.

Students who would like to pay in instalments will pay as follows:

Masters Qualifying Programme Fee as deposit	£1950
Plus the deposit for the MBA Full time programme	£3000
Total -	£4950

(The balance fee for the MBA can be paid as mentioned under the MBA section of this fee sheet)

Degree Foundation Programme (DFP)

Programme Fee: £2950

Students who pay the entire fee of the Degree Foundation Programme and the BA (Hons) in Business Administration programme at the time of deposit or prior to start of the programme will get a 5% fee reduction on both the programmes. It is advisable that students pay the entire fee at the time of accepting the offer, as this considerably increases the chances of getting a visa to the UK and helps students save 5% of the tuition fee.

Students who would like to pay in instalments will pay as follows:

Degree Foundation Programme Fee as Deposit	£2950
Plus deposit towards the Year 1 fee of the BA (Hons) in Business Administration programme.	£2000
Total -	£4950

(At the time of registration for the BA (Hons) in Business Administration programme, the balance payment of £1650 towards the Year 1 fee will be due. The fee for Year 2 and 3 is payable as mentioned under the BA (Hons) section of this fee sheet)



English Grammar and Vocabulary

Programme Fee: £2950

Students who pay the entire fee of the English Grammar and Vocabulary Programme and the BA (Hons) / MBA in Business Administration programme at the time of deposit or prior to start of the programme will get a 5% fee reduction on both the programmes. It is advisable that students pay the entire fee at the time of accepting the offer, as this considerably increases the chances of getting a visa to the UK and helps students save 5% of the tuition fee.

Students who would like to pay in installments will pay as follows :

English Grammar and Vocabulary Fee as Deposit	£2950
Plus	
Deposit towards the Year I fee of the BA (Hons) in Business Administration programme.	£2000
Or	
Deposit towards the MBA Full Time programme	£3000

(The balance fee for the BA (Hons) or MBA can be paid as mentioned under the BA (Hons) or MBA section of this fee sheet)

English for Academic Purposes

Programme Fee: £1500

The entire fee for the English for Academic Purposes has to be paid at the time of payment of the deposit. In addition, the deposit as mentioned under the BA (Hons) or MBA section of this fee sheet, will also need to be paid.

Please Note (For all programmes) :

1. The costs of textbooks and other relevant course materials are NOT included in the tuition fees.
2. Accommodation costs are not included in the tuition fees.
3. Where an applicant is issued a visa but fails to register in time for the programme at TASMALC London, the deposit is not refundable or transferable.
4. Where the applicant provides an original visa refusal letter from the British High Commission stating that the student visa was refused, the deposit will be refunded.
5. The deposit will not be refunded if a visa has been issued.
6. Fees once paid are not refundable.



SCHOLARSHIPS, REWARDS AND FEE WAIVERS

Nationality Scholarship Scheme of £ 1000 for the February 2009 intake

For the February 2009 intake, a Nationality scholarship of £1,000 will be awarded to students (whether self payers or sponsored) from the countries listed below.

This scholarship scheme is to encourage the presence of diverse nationalities on campus so that every student can have opportunities to network, experience and learn from the multi cultural diversity of TASMAC London

Students do not have to apply for this award. All international students who are accepted unconditionally for a programme at TASMAC London from the countries listed below are automatically eligible for the nationality scholarship.

Priority for the Nationality Scholarship will be given to students from the following countries:

Argentina, Bahrain, Bangladesh, Barbados, Belarus, Bulgaria, Brazil, Bosnia, Columbia, Cambodia, China, Croatia, , Cyprus, Dubai, Egypt, Finland, France, Ghana, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Hongkong, India, Iran, Iraq, Iceland, Indonesia, Italy, Jamaica, Japan, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Korea (North and South), Kuwait, Lagos, Lebanon, Libya, Macedonia, Malaysia, Mauritius, Mexico, Morocco, Modova, Montenegro, Nairobi, Nigeria Nepal, Nigeria, Oman, Peru, Panama, Pakistan, Philippines, Poland, Qatar, Romania, Russian Federation, Saudi Arabia, Serbia, Senegal, South Africa, Sri Lanka, Singapore, Sweden, Taiwan, Tanzania, Thailand, Trinidad, Tobago, Turkey, Uganda, UK, Ukraine, Uzbekistan, Vietnam and Zimbabwe.

Please Note:

- The nationality scholarship does not apply to the Masters Qualifying Programme, the Degree Foundation programme and the English Programmes at TASMAC London
- The award is a waiver of the final £ 1000 of the tuition fee paid by an individual student and is not a cash award.
- **Allocation of the Nationality Scholarship:**
 - For Postgraduate students, scholarship of £ 1000 will automatically be deducted from the tuition fee and the student will be required to pay only the balance.
 - For Undergraduate students, the Nationality Scholarship of £ 1000 will be distributed between 3 years - with a scholarship of £ 300 to be awarded in Level I, £ 300 in Level II and £ 400 in Level III respectively.

Refer a Friend Reward

We offer a special Refer a Friend Reward of £ 200 offered to a student for every friend that he/she refers to TASMAC London and who successfully enrolls for a Degree programme. This reward is given to the student in the form of a cheque after his/her friend enrolls at TASMAC London. The Refer a Friend Reward is not limited to the number of friends that can be referred. One student can choose to refer any number of friends who may be interested in a programme at TASMAC London. However, the decision on whether a friend was an actual and fair referral by a student or not, is at the discretion of TASMAC London, based on evidence available. A student who refers his/her Spouse or Sibling will not receive a Refer a Friend Reward as the spouse/ sibling will receive the Sibling / Spouse scholarship.

Sibling and Spouse Scholarships

We are committed to rewarding the loyalty of students who have a sibling (e.g. brother or sister) or spouse (e.g. husband or wife) studying at TASMAC London. International applicants with a sibling who has studied or is studying at TASMAC London may be eligible for a 5% fee reduction for the duration of the course. A Sibling Scholarship Form will need to be completed. This scholarship will be in the form of a discount, given to the student on the total fee that is payable to TASMAC London after deductions of the Nationality Scholarship.



5% Fee waiver

In addition to the above, students will receive a 5 per cent fee waiver on their tuition fees, if they make a full fee payment before commencement of the programme / at the time of registration. This fee waiver will apply to the amount that the student owes TASMAC London after the Nationality scholarship and Sibling/ Spouse Scholarship (if applicable) are deducted. For more information on the 5 % fee waiver on full fees paid, please refer to the section on the specific programme in this literature. This fee waiver is only on tuition fees and does not apply to accommodation charges.

Terms and Conditions for all Scholarships / Fee Waivers above:

1. Applicants must hold an unconditional offer for a BA (Hons) in Business Administration or MBA programme at TASMAC London.
2. The value of the scholarship will be deducted from the programme/ tuition fee. This means that the sum you will be asked to pay will be the equivalent of the programme/ tuition fee minus the value of the scholarship.

Applicants must complete the relevant form to apply for a Sibling/Spouse/ Refer a Friend Reward.
